

5 Ways Pastors Can Actively Support Their Church School By David Cadavero

- Become an active supporter of the church school in your district, and visit the school once per semester (twice per school year) to conduct a chapel service (i.e., have worship and prayer with the faculty and students).
- 2. On a rotating basis conduct a Week-of-Prayer at your district church school. At the conclusion of the Week-of-Prayer, conduct a baptismal class (to be held at the school).
- 3. **Be a positive promoter and advocate for the school**. Preach a sermon focusing on Christian education in the fall and spring.
- 4. Select a church education secretary from each of your congregations. Make sure that person provides the district school principal/academy principal with the names, addresses, and phone numbers of all elementary/academyaged students in the congregation.
- 5. Encourage each church member to support SDA Christian education through a donation of 50¢ per month. (If each member contributed faithfully we would raise thousands of dollars, and the number of students awarded 3-Way Scholarships would increase dramatically).
