Use this calendar to pray each day for your child. Each day has a topic and a prayer paraphrasing a biblical passage for your child.

<b>1</b> <b>Faith</b> Help my child learn that faith is the reality of what is hoped for and the proof of what is not seen (Hebrews 11:1).	<b>2</b> <b>Hope</b> I pray that You, the God of hope, will fill my child with all joy and peace as he trusts in You (Romans 15:13).	<b>3</b> <b>Love of God's Word</b> Help my child remember that peace belongs to those who love Your instruction (Psalm 119:165).	<b>4</b> <b>Joy</b> I pray that You will make my child rejoice because of the works of Your hands (Psalm 92:4).	<b>5</b> <b>Patience</b> Help my child understand that we have hope for what we do not see and can eagerly wait with patience (Romans 8:25).	<b>6</b> <b>Thankfulness</b> Let my child give thanks to You, LORD, for Your faithful love and wonderful works (Psalm 107:8).	<b>7</b> <b>Passion for the Lord</b> May my child long for You just as a deer longs for streams of water (Psalm 42:1).
<b>8</b> <b>Wisdom</b> When my child lacks wisdom, help her understand that she should ask You. You give to all generously and without criticizing (James 1:5).	<b>9</b> <b>Humility</b> May my child learn that the result of humility is fear of You along with wealth, honor, and life (Proverbs 22:4).	<b>10</b> <b>Compassion</b> May my child understand that You are good to everyone; Your compassion rests on all You have made (Psalm 145:9).	<b>11</b> <b>Generosity</b> Instruct my child to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous, and to be willing to share (1 Timothy 6:18).	<b>12</b> <b>Peace</b> Thank You, Lord, that You are able to keep my child in perfect peace as his mind trusts in You (Isaiah 26:3).	<b>13</b> <b>God's Protection</b> I praise You for You are faithful; You will strengthen and guard my child from evil (2 Thessalonians 3:3).	<b>14</b> <b>Seeking the Lord</b> May my child understand that You are good to those who wait for and seek You (Lamentations 3:25).
<b>15</b> <b>Purity</b> Create in my child a clean heart and renew a steadfast spirit within her (Psalm 51:10).	<b>16</b> <b>Integrity</b> Help me, Lord, to teach my child that the one who lives with integrity lives securely (Proverbs 10:9).	<b>17</b> <b>Courage</b> May my child be courageous. It is You who goes with him. You will not leave him (Deuteronomy 31:6).	<b>18</b> <b>Confidence</b> May You be my child's confidence and keep her foot from a snare (Proverbs 3:26).	<b>19</b> <b>Faithfulness</b> Help my child remember that those who plan good find loyalty and faithfulness (Proverbs 14:22).	<b>20</b> <b>Responsibility</b> Help me to teach my child that in this world, each of us is responsible for our own choices (Galatians 6:5).	<b>21</b> <b>Salvation</b> May my child grow to understand that You saved us according to Your mercy (Titus 3:5).
<b>22</b> <b>Contentment</b> I pray that my child may accept and live knowing that godliness with contentment is great gain (1 Timothy 6:6).	<b>23</b> <b>Righteousness</b> Help me to model for my child that You are righteous and You love righteous deeds. (Psalm 11:7).	<b>24</b> <b>God's Grace</b> Thank You for Your grace so that my child may have everything he needs and may excel in good works for You (2 Corinthians 9:8).	<b>25</b> <b>Self-Control</b> Do not allow my child to be tempted beyond what he can bear, but provide a way of escape for him (1 Corinthians 10:13).	<b>26</b> <b>Mercy</b> Help me teach my child that Your mercy is from generation to generation for those who fear You (Luke 1:50).	<b>27</b> <b>Obedience to God</b> Remind my child to obey You rather than men (Acts 5:29).	<b>28</b> <b>Steadfastness</b> May my child be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in Your work. Her labor will not be in vain (1 Corinthians 15:58).
<b>29</b> <b>Servant's Heart</b> May my child not lack diligence and be fervent in spirit as he serves You (Romans 12:11).	<b>30</b> <b>Trust</b> Help my child understand that it is better to take refuge in You than to trust in other people (Psalm 118:8).	<b>31</b> <b>Reliance on God</b> May my child grow to trust You with all of her heart and not lean on her own understanding (Proverbs 3:5).
