How to Use the Weekly Prayer List

- Use the weekly prayer list only once each week with Morning Prayer.
- ILLUSTRATION: During the week, the classroom teacher should find up in prayer GNYA principal, teachers, staff and students.
- The teacher should personalize the prayer by identifying the principal by name and about the special needs of the school, something special about the school, etc.)
- Ideally, the classroom teacher or a student trained by him or her, should call the school or persons who are going to be identified for the following week, and find out personal information that would be of interest to the students in the classroom. This will help make the weekly prayer list "come alive" and be meaningful to each student.
