A cause-and-effect essay describes the relationship between an event or circumstance and its causes. Good cause-and-effect essays contain

- A clearly stated topic that explains what cause-and-effect relationships will be explored
- An effective and logical method of organization
- Details and examples that elaborate upon the writer's statements
- Transitions that smoothly and clearly connect the writer's ideas

Cause-and-effect relationships are explored in many types of writing, including the following:

- Historical articles that explain how events in history contributed to or resulted in other events
- Process explanations that take readers step by step through a process such as a math formula or a scientific technique
- Predictions that make educated guesses about future events based on knowledge of cause-and-effect relationships
