

Meet the Pioneers who worked together to bring about the start of our Seventh-day Adventist Church.










# Angeline S. Stevens Andrews



Birth: 1792, Fairhaven, Massachusetts






## Goodloe Harper Bell








# Cyrus K. Farnsworth







Birth: January 26, 1832 Death: 1924 Accomplishments: Preacher, literature evangelist, author of <u>Hand Book of Health</u>








## William Miller




# Memorial Stone Bucks Bridge, New York


