Spider Vocabulary

Arachnids

The class of animals that spiders belong to; arachnids are animals that have



an exoskeleton, a two-part segmented body, and eight jointed legs. Arachnids are cold-blooded and do not have a backbone.

Arachnophobia

Fear of spiders.

Abdomen

A section of the spider's body that contains the guts, heart, silk glands, and reproductive glands.

Burrow

A hole or tunnel dug in the ground by an animal.



Camouflage

Coloring that makes it easy to blend into nearby areas

Cephalothorax

A section of the spider's body that contains the legs, eyes, and mouthparts.

Cobweb

Old tangled spiderweb that has collected dust and dirt.

Dragline

Long silk threads that trail behind the spider.



Egg Sac

Sac made of silk that holds and protects the spider eggs.

Habitat

Area where an animal normally lives.

Molting

When the spider sheds its skin.

Orb web

Circular web spun by a spider.

Pedicel

The spider's waist, which connects the cephalothorax and the abdomen.

Pedipalps or Palps

Two sensory feelers that look like very short legs.

Prey

An animal hunted for food.

Silk

A fine threadlike material spun by a spider

Spiderlings

Baby spiders.

Spinnerets

Where the spider's silk is made. On the hind end; there are usually six of them.

Web

Pieces of silk put together by a spider.


Spider Maze
