Characteristics and Classification of Organisms Part 7

Characteristic 5: Organisms grow and develop

Growth-

• the increase in body mass or formation of new body structures

Development-

• all the changes that takes place during an organism's life cycle

Metamorphosis-

• series of changes in body structure from egg to adult

Complete metamorphosis-

• Adult organism looks little like its youth counterpart.

Incomplete metamorphosis-

• Adult organism looks similar, but larger, than youth counterpart.
