Students play a game where they must line up according to the number given to them

Students model the teacher as they learn to sing a song about counting and add movement to the song. In this lesson about music and counting, students read a book, sing the song that goes with the book and role-play. Students pretend they are the ants from the book as they practice counting from 1-10 and act-out the song with movement. Students create ten ants, with construction paper and craft sticks, to continue their practice of counting.
