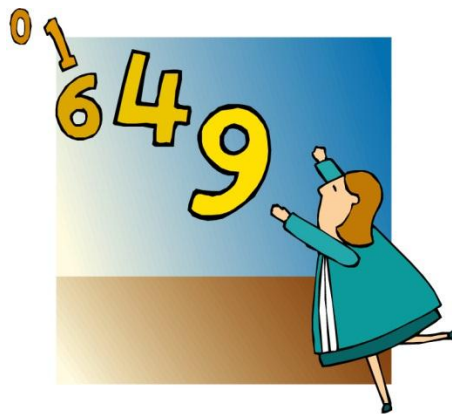


M.K.NO.5 Begin to organize objects up to 19 into groups of tens and ones.

Useful manipulatives include counters, blocks, shapes and unifix blocks, popsicle sticks, and pattern blocks.

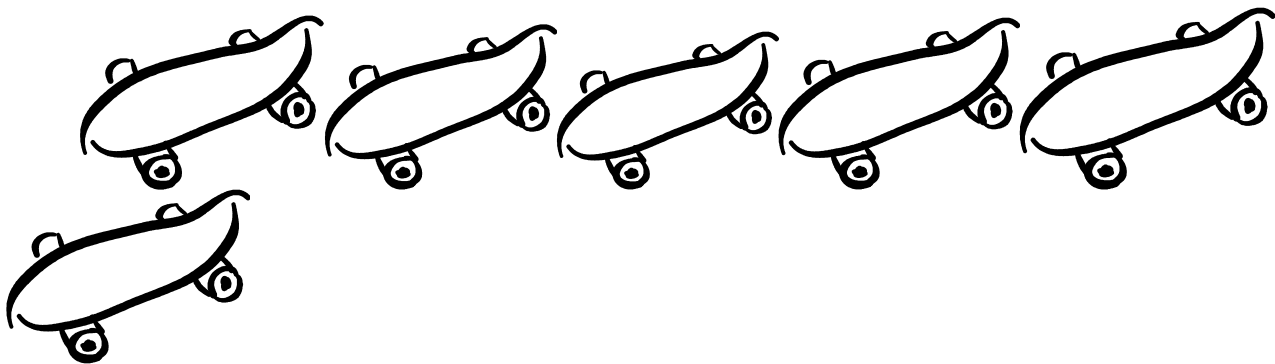

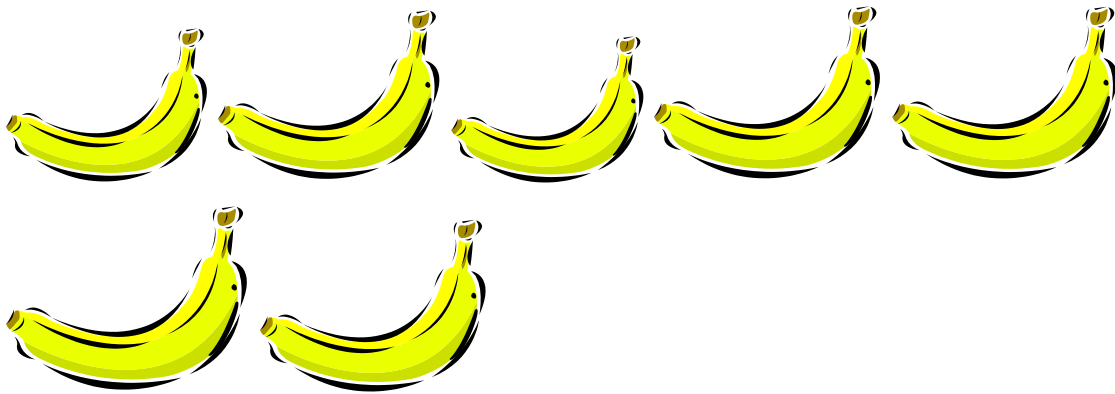

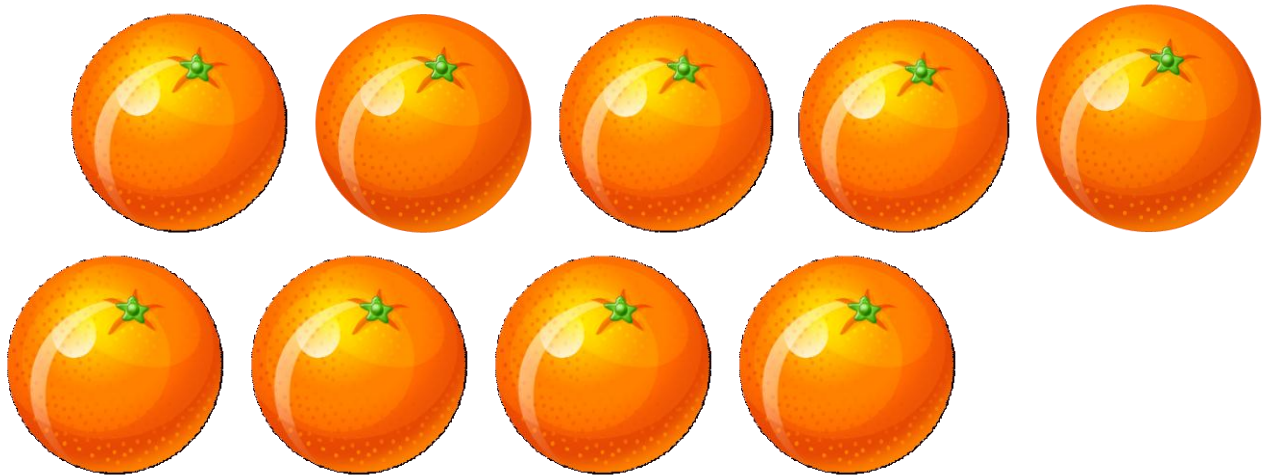

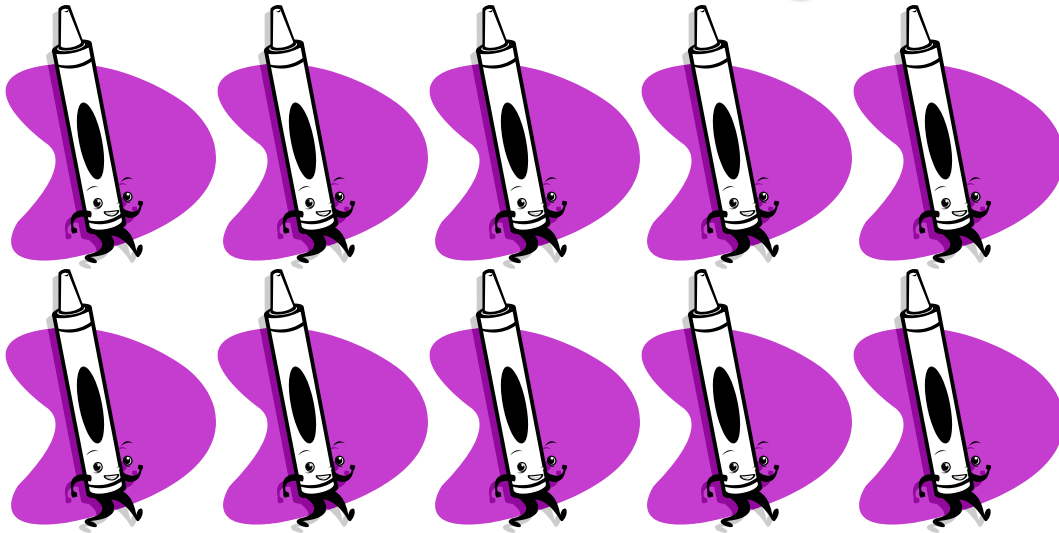
