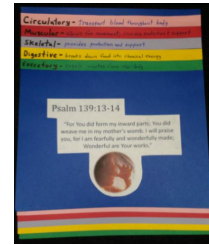


Flip Chart Instructions

Materials:

- 6 different colored construction or cardstock paper (cardstock works best)
Each color will represent a different organ system
- Pictures from magazines or off the internet (preferably colored) unless instructed to draw
- 2 colored markers
- Glue
- Stapler

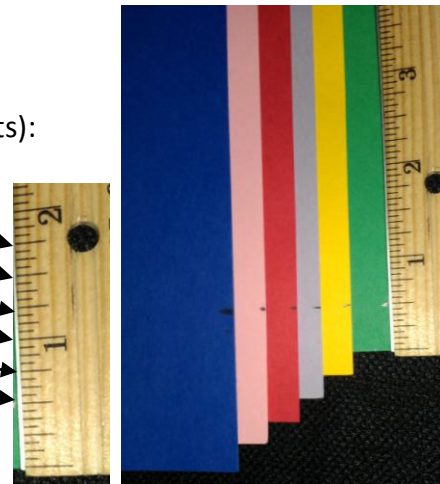


Directions:

1. Arrange your papers in the order you wish to flip through them.
2. You will cut each paper a different length in order to have quarter inch tabs on your flipchart. Save all pieces of paper you cut to be used later.

3. Cut each paper as follows:

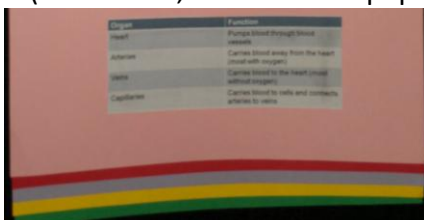
- a) 1st sheet (which will be your cover and table of contents):
cut off 1 ¾ inches off the bottom
- b) 2nd: cut 1 ½ inches off the bottom
- c) 3rd: cut 1 ¼ inch off the bottom
- d) 4th: cut 1 inches off the bottom
- e) 5th: cut ¾ inches off the bottom
- f) 6th: cut ½ inches off the bottom



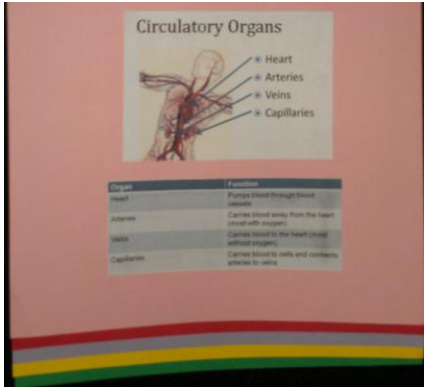
4. Stack your papers so that the top of all sheets are aligned with each other and so you can see the quarter inch tabs at the bottom of the sheets. (Remember that the shortest paper is your cover. Put it aside till later.)



5. Choose five systems that you will display in your flip chart. For each system, create a table that names the organs and describes the function of each of those organs. Paste your table to your paper (remember, each colored paper represents a different organ system).



6. Find pictures (or draw) the major organs of those systems. Paste your pictures to your paper.



7. Restack your papers (including the cover) so that the top of all sheets are aligned with each other and so you can see the quarter inch tabs at the bottom of the sheets.

8. Staple all six of your papers at the top.

9. Take the strips of papers you have from steps 2 and 3 and cut each one to make 1/2 inch strips. These will be used to make your table of contents.



10. Rather than using page numbers, the table of contents will be color coordinated. On each strip, write the name of the organ system (represented by the color) and its function. Then paste each strip at the top of your cover page with the color of the 2nd page at the top, 3rd page following, and so on.



11. Find a picture or scripture to paste (or draw) on your cover page.
